This week we continue the series with our attention on loving our neighbors who are poor. The Bible has a lot to say about this subject – there are about 400 references to caring for the poor! We'll use Mark 10:17-31 (CEB) to guide us as we consider the questions "Who are the poor of today?" and "Why does God call us to care for them?"

The Bible Project is a great (free!) resource to help people understand more about the context of the Bible, as well as how themes are woven throughout the different books. I'd encourage you to listen to Tim's (short) message and watch the video on justice.
